We invite you to pedal embraced by 14,000 foot mountain peaks beneath the forever reaching Colorado blue skies! Surrounded by the dramatic Sangre de Cristo and San Juan Mountains, the high desert of our expansive San Luis Valley offers cooler temperatures and an array of outdoor recreation. At an elevation of 7,500 ft., experience one of the world's largest and highest alpine valleys, covering an area the size of Connecticut. For scenic sites & lodging see www.alamosa.org.

Bike 2 Build is a benefit ride for Habitat for Humanity. The ride is a fully supported with reststops every 20-30 miles with snacks, water, good conversation, porta-potty facilities, sag vehicles. This year's ride has a Metric Century (65-mile) and a 30-mile loop.

Habitat for Humanity has been serving families in the San Luis Valley for over 30 years!! Habitat for Humanity is a housing ministry working with low-income families and volunteers to build simple, decent, affordable homes. Habitat Homes are purchased by applicant families with no-profit, 0% interest mortgages.
